## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. Date, Venue & Organising Authority

The 2018 Cairn Curran Regatta will be held from 17–18 November 2018 inclusive.

The organising authority for this regatta is the Cairn Curran Sailing Club Inc.

### 2. Rules

The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the relevant Class Rules and the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of the Australian Sailing, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. AS Special Regulations, Part 2, Off The Beach Boats will apply.

### 3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all Off the Beach Sailing Boats. All competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Rules and will be required to provide their AS membership number as a part of the registration process.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter on the Entry Form available at registration.

### 4. Fees

Regatta entry fee **All sessions** Single handed \$60 / Crewed boats \$70 Juniors \$30  
**Single sessions** All boats \$40 Juniors \$20

*When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable. To alert boats that another race or sequence of races will begin soon, the postponement signal may be displayed for at least one minute before a warning signal is displayed.*

### 6. Measurement

Competing yachts shall conform to the measurement requirements specified by their respective Class Rules.

### 7. Sailing Instructions

Will be posted at Cairn Curran Sailing Club prior to the Information session on Saturday 17 November 2018

### 8. Regatta Site

The regatta site will be at Cairn Curran Sailing Club.

## **9. Racing Area**

The racing area will be on the waters of Cairn Curran Reservoir.

## **10. Courses**

The format and courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions/Club Notice Board.

## **11. Support Boats**

Team Managers, Coaches, and other support Personnel shall keep more than 50 metres clear of any competitor or mark of the course between the preparatory signal and the finish of the last boat in a race, except in boats provided by the organising authority or when asked to assist by the Race Committee.

## **12. Radio Communications**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive communications not available to all boats for the purpose of obtaining outside assistance. This requirement also applies to mobile telephone communications.

## **13. Divisions & Trophies**

Divisions will be set by Cairn Curran Sailing Club. Based on numbers and types of entries. (eg. cats, monos and Class fleets of 5 or more). Trophies will be awarded at the discretion of The Cairn Curran Sailing Club Inc.

- 1) The most recent version of the AS Yardstick System (on AS website) will be used in calculating the mixed class fleet racing results.
- 2) The AS Yardstick numbers to be used for each class, adjusted as necessary for variations from Base Rig.
- 3) Boats without AS Yardstick numbers published in the current listing will be allocated numbers (eg. informed by older YV listings where available)
- 4) AS Yardstick numbers may be adjusted during the series at the sole discretion of the race committee, whose decision will be final.

## **14. Social Evening**

There will be one organised social function held at Cairn Curran Sailing Club on the evening of Saturday 17 November 2018. \$25 per adult, \$13 per child <12yo

## **15. Canteen and Bar**

The club canteen will operate during the regatta between approximately 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours daily for the purchase of breakfast, hot and cold food, drinks and preparation of lunch orders. Lunch orders (rolls, sandwiches) will be ordered and paid for before first race of the day and be available for collection. The club bar will operate according to club requirements during the regatta.

## **16. Entry Disclaimer**

It is the competitor's decision to enter the event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority, and the host club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this event or howsoever arising in connection with this event.

## **17. Insurance**

All boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than \$AUD 5,000,000 (recommend \$AUD 10,000,000 or equivalent thereof in any other currency) for any accident. All owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owner/competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

## **18. Camping**

Limited unpowered camping is available in club grounds. The club has a 'No dogs' policy . No camp fires. No generators. Camping by-laws and camping charges of \$12 per person per night apply. These are outlined on <http://www.ccsc.org.au/camping-at-ccsc.html>
