NOTICE OF RACE

1. Date, Venue & Organising Authority

Regatta will be held from 7–8 December 2019 inclusive.

The organising authority for this regatta is the Cairn Curran Sailing Club Inc.

2. Rules

The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2017–2020 (RRS), the relevant Class Rules and the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. AS Special Regulations, Part 2, Off The Beach Boats will apply.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of classic classes.

All competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Rules.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter on the Entry Form available at registration.

4. Fees

Regatta entry fee (all sessions): all boats \$30

When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable. To alert boats that another race or sequence of races will begin soon, the postponement signal may be displayed for at least one minute before a warning signal is displayed.

6. Sailing Instructions

Club Racing Sailing Instructions will apply and will be posted at Cairn Curran Sailing Club

8. Regatta Site

The Regatta site will be at Cairn Curran Sailing Club.

9. Racing Area

The racing area will be on the waters of Cairn Curran Reservoir.

10. Courses

The format and courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions/Club Notice Board.

13. Divisions & Trophies

Divisions and trophies will be determined by the relevant class associations and event organisers; Victorian Classic Dinghy Network and Cairn Curran Sailing Club.

14. Social Evening

There will be one organised social function held at Cairn Curran Sailing Club on the evening of Saturday 7 December 2019. \$25 adult, \$13 children <12yo.

15. Catering and Bar

The Club Canteen will operate during the regatta between approximately 0800 hours and 1800 hours daily for the purchase of breakfast, hot and cold food, drinks and preparation of lunch orders. The Club Bar will operate according to club requirements during the regatta. NB: In accordance with our licence no BYO alcohol permitted.

16. Entry Disclaimer

It is the competitor's decision to enter the event or to start and continue in any race.

Competitors shall accept that their participation in the event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority, and the host club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this event or howsoever arising in connection with this event.

17. Insurance

All boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than \$AUD 5,000,000 (recommend \$AUD 10,000,000 or equivalent thereof in any other currency) for any accident. All owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

18. Camping

Limited unpowered camping is available in club grounds. The club has a 'No dogs' policy . No camp fires. No generators. Camping by-laws and camping charges of \$12 per person per night (max. \$50 per site).
